The Dufferin Agricultural Scholarship is a scholarship awarded annually to a student or students who will be pursuing agricultural related studies in a university or college.

Participation in an animal related club or organization is not necessarily criteria for eligibility, although such participation is encouraged and will be taken into consideration.

Any student who is actively involved in the Carman Country fair, through exhibiting or volunteering, will be eligible to apply. Scholarship may be divided between applicants, depending on number of scholarships awarded.

Judging Criteria:

- Candidate must be a resident of Manitoba
- Candidate must be 22 years of age or younger
- The candidate must be registered (or accepted) or presently attending a post secondary institution or apprenticeship program
- The candidate must make a positive impact on or contribution to his/ her community

Application must contain:

- Proof of senior 4 or equivalent
- Proof of acceptance to agriculture or related program
- Letters of reference from at least two people (teacher, employer, community leader etc.)
- Resume including; education, employment and volunteer experience, community and school activities
- An essay of not more than one and not less than one half page on one of the following topics:
 - Going Green: Environmental Efforts in Agriculture
 - Food, Fuels & More: Exploring the Future of Agriculture
 - Agriculture Around The World: Where Does Canada Stand?
 - Organics: A Trend or a Tremendous Opportunity?
 - Leadership in Agriculture: What Does it Take?
