- Applicants must be a graduate from a high school within the boundaries of the town of Carman or the municipalities of Dufferin, Grey, Thompson or Roland
- Applicants will be expected to meet with the selection committee and be willing to present a portfolio or example of their work

### REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must plan on attending a Fine Arts post-secondary education course that is at least six months in duration at a recognized institution for the school year the scholarship is to be awarded.
- Applicants must have a focused area of study; Golden Prairie Arts Council will not fund the first year (University One) or foundation year of general university education.

### APPLICANTS WILL BE SELECTED ON A COMBINATION OF:

- A sample of their work (musical ability, visual arts, writing, dance etc.)
- Academic standing
- A commitment to their area of study
