CRITERIA:

Marks are allocated for presentation.

ELIGIBILITY:

All Indigenous children/grandchildren (including foster children/grandchildren) of National Union of Public and General Employees' current/retired members and who are planning to enter the 1st year of a Canadian public, post-secondary education institution full-time in 2019/2020 are eligible to apply.

AWARD:

The amount of the scholarship is \$1.500.
