## CRITERIA:

Winner will be determined on the basis of a 750 to 1,000 word essay on:

*The importance of quality public services in enhancing the quality of life of Indigenous students.*

An application form must be completed and accompany the essay.

Marks are allocated for presentation.

## ELIGIBILITY:

All Indigenous children/grandchildren (including foster children/grandchildren) of National Union of Public and General Employees' current/retired members and who are planning to enter the 1<sup>st</sup> year of a Canadian **public**, post-secondary education institution full-time in 2019/2020 are eligible to apply.

## AWARD:

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,500.
